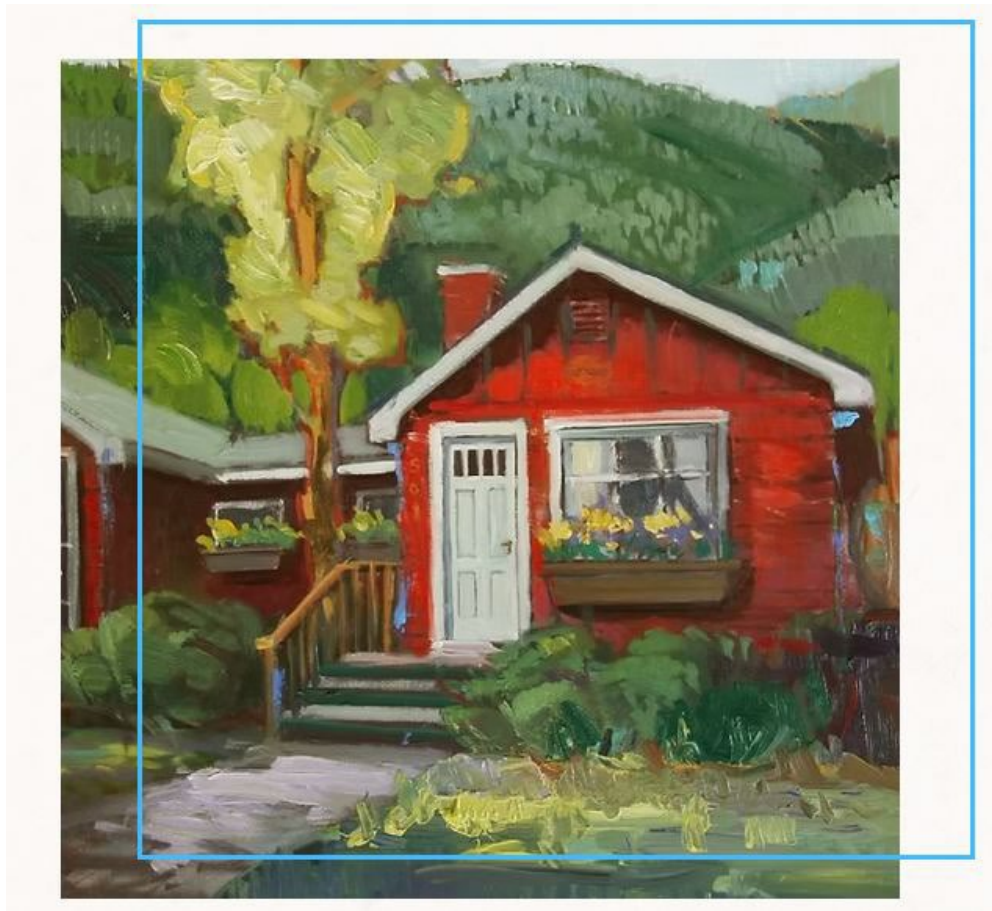

In 2025, we continued our mission of providing compassionate, high-quality care to individuals and families throughout the Wood River Valley and surrounding communities. With deep gratitude, we reflect on a year defined by service, connection, and presence—walking alongside those facing serious illness, grief, and end-of-life journeys, guided always by our core values of dignity, respect, and love.

2025 marked a historic milestone: our 40th year of service. Since 1985, we have remained a trusted source of comfort, support, and expert care during life's most vulnerable moments. Over four decades, our organization has grown alongside this community, serving generations of families and building enduring relationships grounded in trust and compassion.

Throughout the year, our 40th Anniversary Awareness Campaign served as both a celebration of our legacy and a commitment to the future. The campaign elevated stories from patients, families, volunteers, and staff; expanded educational outreach within the community; introduced a refreshed website experience; and strengthened fundraising efforts to support long-term sustainability. These initiatives increased awareness of our services and reinforced our role as an essential, accessible resource for compassionate care.

In support of our commitment to clinical excellence, we welcomed a Board-Certified Palliative Care physician to our team in 2025. Bringing a wealth of experience, this addition enhanced our interdisciplinary approach to care while strengthening support for both patients and families. The physician also plays an integral role in mentoring and supporting our clinical team, further elevating the quality and continuity of services we provide.

Community connection and gratitude were central themes of the year. In September, we hosted our first inaugural Donor Appreciation Event, honoring the individuals and partners whose steadfast generosity has sustained our mission over time. This gathering offered an opportunity to express heartfelt thanks, share the impact of their support, and deepen relationships that are essential to the future of our organization.

Throughout 2025, our dedicated staff and volunteers delivered skilled medical care, emotional support, and comprehensive bereavement services to hundreds of individuals and families. From responding to sudden loss to providing ongoing grief support and end-of-life care, our team ensured that no one faced serious illness or loss alone.

As we look beyond our 40th year, we remain committed to listening to community needs, expanding services, and advocating for compassionate care at every stage of life. With the continued support of our community, we move forward with confidence—honoring our past while shaping a future rooted in dignity, connection, and care.

The Hospice and Palliative Care of the Wood River Valley is privately-funded and privately-governed. Unlike most hospices, **it receives no government funding**. It depends on individual donations and grants. Our services continue to be free of charge.
